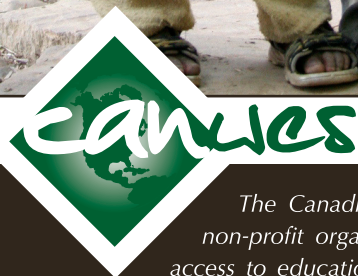


Canadian World Education Society

The Everest English School

In August of 2009 the Canadian World Education Society (CanWES) proudly celebrated its third year of existence. It now successfully owns and operates the Everest English School (EES), located in the remote village of Sanitar, Nepal. Currently at EES there are 160 students in attendance and 12 paid staff members.

To date, EES is able to accommodate students up to grade four. Our Goal is to raise enough funds to construct another building, adding grades five through eight to the school. This not only provides more opportunity for the children, but also allows the people of Sanitar to earn a living while constructing the building. Local villagers do everything from hand-making bricks to cutting down trees for lumber. CanWES hopes to add one more grade to the school each year, thereby providing quality education to the children of Sanitar for many years to come.
