

In March 2009 was the first time I visited the Everest English. I collected some books from family and friends in Tipperary and Kerry, Ireland to bring to the school. I spent 10 days in Sanitar teaching the children, and helping the teachers prepare for examinations. I was very impressed at how enthusiastic and dedicated the teachers at the Everest English School are, and also how motivated the children are to receive this education.

Following my return to Tipperary, Ireland in April 2009, I was invited to speak to my local primary school in Tipperary about Everest English School and Sanitar Village. The Teachers and students became interested in the School and in October 2009 the teachers organized a NO UNIFORM DAY in the School and they collected 300- which I brought with me when I traveled to Sanitar in October. The School also donated pencils, crayons, and other stationery items, which were necessary for the school. I went with the teachers of the Everest English School to the Okhaldhunga village to purchase necessary resources that were needed for the classrooms; posters, copybooks, floor-covering, paint, and also some sports equipment.

When I returned to Tipperary in November I went to speak to the teachers and students in Mount Bruis School about my visit. They are very interested in keeping up the contact with Everest English School both culturally and educationally.

So hopefully 2010 should be a prosperous year for Everest English School.
